The Reserve at Lake Keowee Residents Raise Over \$3,700 for the Foothills Humane Society

GREENVILLE, SC – June 23, 2009 – The 2nd Annual Memorial Day Concert and Wine Auction at The Reserve at Lake Keowee took place on Friday, May 22 and raised over \$3,300.
